

YJS ETE Lead to notify manager of relevant SEND team and virtual school of detention

YJS must inform both the LA SEN teams in instances where a detained child is in care to Surrey County Council and living out of the area on going into custody. SEND manager and link SCM will notify the relevant SEND Case Officer.

SEND CW to send all relevant information to YJS ETE Lead who will ensure it reaches the custodial establishment and relevant health commissioners within 5 days of becoming aware of the detention

If EHC plan exists prior to detention, SEND CW to send all relevant documents to the Designated Clinical Officer

The **SEND Case Worker** should advise the social worker when a detained child with an EHC plan has a social care needs specified in the EHC plan.

Social Worker **must give consideration** to whether social care needs specified in the EHC plan continue in custody

If EHC plan exists prior to detention, the LA must arrange appropriate special education, social care and health provision for the child whilst in custody. The LA must arrange and **monitor** any special educational provision specified in the EHC plan, or as close to it as possible, while in custody and after release from custody. This must be done by working closely with the relevant person in charge of education at the youth accommodation.

If EHC plan exists prior to detention, or an EHC plan is issued whilst the child is in custody, the SEN team **MUST** maintain the EHC plan whilst child is detained. The LA must review the EHC plan after release and maintain EHC plan, if appropriate.

the custodial establishment undertake health needs assessment (CHAT) and develops an IHCP, taking into account EHC plan

The custodial establishment's education provider makes provision for child's education, health and social care needs as identified in the EHC plan as requested by the LA

Custodial establishment to inform YJS if child is transferred between custodial establishments or being released from custody YJS **must** notify the relevant quadrant SEN team when the child is transferred between custodial establishments or is being released from custody.

SEN CW to send all relevant information to new establishment within 5 days of becoming aware of the detention, via the YJS ETE Lead
